Whether you work with children or adults, with individuals just getting started or those at the end of life, including individuals with intellectual or other disabilities, there is a fundamental question. What matters to the person receiving support? Reporters say “Don’t bury the lead.” In our work, what matters to the person receiving support is arguably the lead. How do you find the answer to that question and what do you do with the information? That is our ethical concern.

There are almost always competing factors: between needs and wants; between stated goals (*I want to be a nurse*) and what those goals might mean daily (*I want to help*); between imposed behavioral expectations and a life that feels satisfying. There might be realities of limited time and resources. All things considered, what is our ethical obligation to identify and acknowledge what matters most to a person receiving support.
